Lunches and Snacks

Bring a small nutritious snack, bag lunch and drink each day. For full day camps please ensure your child has enough food, as the children are very active and tend to eat more than usual. Allergy Alert: - please DO NOT BRING peanut or other nut products in snacks or lunches.

Forms and Waivers

Please fill out and promptly return all waivers and forms. Camp fees vary due to specialty supply costs, transportation, specialty instructors and/or field trip admissions.

Swimming

Swim days will be noted on your receipt. All participants 7 years of age and under will be required to wear a life-jacket (provided by Trico Centre; unless they can swim two widths of the pool with out stopping). On the days scheduled for swimming, your preschooler should come to camp with a swimsuit on, or under their clothes and bring a towel. Preschoolers must be toilet-trained.

Children's Belongings

Wear comfortable play clothes and sneakers. Don't forget your hat, sunscreen and/or rain gear. Please dress for the weather as camps go on field-trips and also have outdoor time each day. Bring belongings in a knapsack labeled with your name.

Lost and Found

All lost and found items will be forwarded to the Guest Services area. Trico Centre is not responsible for lost or damaged goods.

Where to Meet

Appropriate signage will be posted to help you locate your camp group. Meet and pick up will be held in same location all week.

Pre, Post and Lunch Care

Please register for pre, post and lunch room supervision if required. Pre and Post camp care is provided at \$5.00 / hour / child. No discounts or pro-rating.
